Nils Erikson's third solo piano album *Confessions for a Piano* is finally here. It's rooted in the same impressionist soil as the former albums *Secrets for a Piano* and *Revelations for a Piano*. However, this time the roots go deeper and wider.

One important difference is the way in which the album is released. *Secrets* was first published on CD and then as streaming files (Spotify, Apple Music etc). *Revelations* is only availabe as streaming files.

Confessions takes a step away from this and is relased on reel-to-reel magnetic tape only, 100% analogue.

Still, any buyer of this exclusive product will be personally authorized to redistribute it digitally *in any way*, without paying any royalties. The only prerequisite is to clearly state the source and not put the music along any illegal or offensive material.

The numbered and signed reel-to-reel magnetic tape has a colour printed cover and will cost 114€, shipping within Sweden included. The default format is 1/4-inch tape width with 2 tracks on a 7 inch reel at 7,5 inches/second. Other formats, such as 4-track tape, are possible on request.

Each tape is made on-demand on a Revox B77 MkII, directly from the original grand piano recording. The album is 35 minutes long and contains ten all new pieces. A YouTube teaser is available *here*:
